Bariatric Patient Chair/Dinner Chair

Specially designed patient chair that ensures good seating comfort for bariatric users. Patient chairs are used in waiting rooms, in hospitals and institutions and in private homes.

User weight up to 325 kg. Available in two sizes, 61 cm, and 71 cm width.

Patient Chair may tip or break if the max. weight limit is exceeded. Maximum user weight 325 kg.



3. General comments

The UDI number of Patient Chair appears on the label, which is located on the side of the frame.

4. Use

Patient Chair is a very strong chair ensuring good seating comfort for users weighing up to 325 kg. Patient Chair is available in two seat width, 61 cm, and 71 cm.

Patient Chair is equipped with a wide seat which together with the curved armrests ensures good space between the armrests. The seat depth can also be adjusted in three different depths.

The design of the back and seat allows the user to sit completely back in the seat, which can be preferable when the chair is used as a dining chair at a table.

⚠ Patient Chair may tip or break if the max. weight limit is exceeded.

Contraindications

Monitor users with cognitive impairment while using the Patient Chair.

5. Setting

Assembly of Patient Chair

Patient Chair consists of two parts, the chair frame, and the backrest.

1. Put a washer on each bolt. Fastened the backrest to the chair frame by inserting the four bolts and washers into holes, two on each side. Tighten them well with the accompanying hexagon allen key.

Adjustment of the seat depth and backrest

1. The seat depth can be adjusted into three positions. Choose two holes (front, middle or back) on the backrest for the desired seat depth. See the instruction above.

Adjustment of the height settings of the leg

1. The height of the legs can be adjusted into six positions by loosening and tightening the four bolts already mounted on the legs. Use both hexagon allen keys when adjusting.

Tools to use

1. Two 5 mm hexagon allen keys, four hex sockets allen key bolts, four washers.

During use

The backrest can be adjusted in three different depths. Adjusting the seat depth does not affect the stability of the chair.

6. Long-term storage

When the Patient Chair is not in use, store it in a dry place and between -10 – 40°C.

7. Cleaning and maintenance

The Patient Chair frame and seat is cleaned using water and a regular cleaning agent.

Disinfection

Patient Chair can be disinfected using ethanol 70-85% or a chlorine product of min. 1000 ppm and max. 10000 ppm.

 Always remember to disinfect Patient Chair when transferred to a new user. This is done to avoid cross-contamination and infections.

Local cleaning and disinfection procedures must always be followed.

Maintenance

Bolts and washers should be checked regularly and replaced if necessary.

 Failure to check bolts and washers as instructed may cause malfunction.

8. Disposal

Dispose of products that are no longer in use in an environmentally safe manner.

Contact your local authority or Cobi Rehab for further information on disposal.

Recycling

9. Warranty

Cobi Rehab warrants that the Patient Chair is without defects on delivery. If, against all expectations, the Patient Chair is subject to deficiencies or defects on receipt, please contact Cobi Rehab immediately.

The warranty period for the Patient Chair is one year from the date of purchase and covers manufacturing defects or defect on receipt. The invoice is your certificate of warranty.

The warranty does not apply to:

- products on which the serial number, batch number or the like have been removed or significantly damaged.
- products which have been repaired by unauthorised personnel.

9.1 Unintended events

Report any incidents related to the use of the Patient Chair to Cobi Rehab.

9.2 After expiry of the expected service life

After the expected service life, it is important that an overall assessment of the product is made before continued use.
